The PROMPT Wales Official Launch took place on the 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2018 at the Clayton Hotel, Cardiff.



It was a huge success with representation from all 7 Health Boards.

Special guests included Neil Frow, Managing Director of NHS Wales Shared Services Partnership (NWSSP); Dr Frank Atherton, Chief Medical Officer for Wales and Professor Jean White CBE, Chief Nursing Officer for Wales.

The PROMPT Wales team entertained audiences with an insight in to everyday obstetric emergencies by demonstrating a sepsis drill and a PPH drill. Both scenarios were facilitated by the PROMPT Wales team supported by the PROMPT Maternity Foundation and the OBS Cymru team.

Local faculty development days are well underway. The PROMPT Wales team have supported and facilitated in Local Faculty Development days at ABUHB, ABMUHB, CVUHB & CTUHB.

It was extremely humbling to see the enthusiasm and commitment that all the Health Boards have for the future development of PROMPT Wales within their local units.

ABMU have increased their faculty members to **53** ABUHB have increased their faculty members to **34**

#### PROMPT Wales Clinical Outcomes

To evaluate the impact of PROMPT Wales, the team will be examining various clinical outcomes, pre- and post- implementation including:

- 1. 5 Minute Apgar <7
- 2. Hypoxic Ischaemic Encephalopathy
- 3. Unexpected NICU Admission at Term
- 4. Shoulder dystocia
- 5. Brachial Plexus Injury
- 6. Post Partum Haemorrhage
- 7. Maternal admission to Level 2/3 care

Safety Attitude Questionnaire (SAQ)

The first round of SAQs has finished, with 354 questionnaires returned from midwives, support staff, obstetricians and anaesthetists across all Health Boards.

Safety Attitude is an established and effective tool in reviewing the standards of safety in maternity services.

We will be undertaking a comparative round of questionnaires after the majority of staff have attended their PROMPT Wales training.
