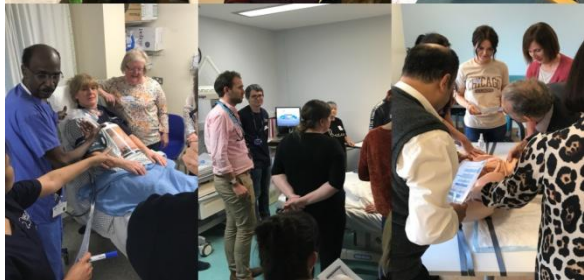
January “The Implementation Month”

A huge CONGRATULATIONS to all **7 Health Boards** for implementing PROMPT Wales!



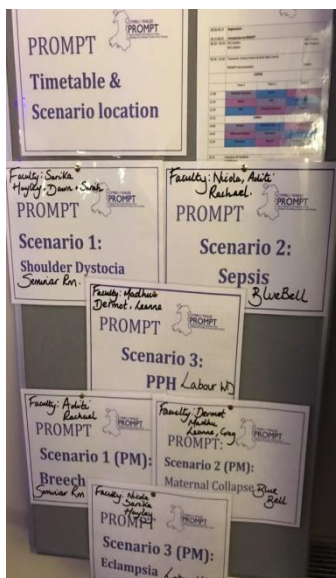
Some units have implemented PROMPT for the very first time whereas others have modified their existing PROMPT to PROMPT Wales.

PROMPT PROPS & TIPS:

Here is the lovely Sue from Powys THB who has kindly shared her amazing 'Fake Blood Recipe' for a PPH station.

Ingredients:

2 litres of water
Cornflour
Food colouring:
Red, Blue & Purple

Preparation:

Split up coloured liquid into 4 x 500ml lots

With the first 500mls

Put 1–2 heaped desert spoons of cornflour in & stir well.
Play with colour until you think it looks dark red enough.
Heat on stove until thickening.
Don't worry if it looks whitish, it will change when cooked.
Remember it gets thicker when it is cool.

Use that as your basis for thicker or thinner blood with the other 3 lots.
TOP TIP: Even thin blood needs a bit of thickener in it!

Storage: Put the thick custard into container. Thinner blood into plastic bottles.

When you make up your blood loss, use different thickness blood to make it look realistic. **Thank You Sue for your PROP Tips!!**
