

Information for New Students

With the implementation of the NHS Wales Terms & Conditions, in order to access the NHS Wales Bursary, will be required to commit to working in Wales after graduation.

Please review the NHS Wales Terms & Conditions and the associated FAQs carefully before confirming your funding route: <u>New Students - NHS Wales Shared Services Partnership</u>

Opting into the NHS Wales Bursary Scheme:

Students will need to ensure they register and apply within **10 weeks** of the start of their course to be considered for a bursary. **Applications submitted after this date will not be accepted.**

Opting out of the NHS Wales Bursary Scheme

Students will need to register a BOSS account regardless of their funding decision.

If you would like to opt out of the NHS Wales Bursary, please register your decision via the BOSS system to access your unique reference number (FRSL). Once registered, you will be provided with an email under the 'Documents' section of your account to send to the required funding body (Student Finance Wales / England).

Changing Funding Route

Students will have up to 10 weeks from the start of their course to change funding route. Students will need to contact us via abm.sas@wales.nhs.uk as soon as possible, so we may take the appropriate steps and advise further.

In normal circumstances, students will not be able to change funding route after the 10-week deadline. However, in exceptional cases your application to change funding route will be considered. If you would like to change funding route please ask your university to email

<u>HEIW.EdCommissioning@wales.nhs.uk</u> with a rationale as to why you would like to change. Any such cases will then be considered on a case by case basis and a decision will be made by HEIW and communicated to the student.
