A Healthier Wales - Primary Care Sustainability

The Health Minister Vaughan Gething has announced that from the 1 April 2019 GP Practices in Wales will benefit from:

- GPWales a website designed by GP's for GP's to advertise multidisciplinary practice vacancies and enabling effective sign-posting and introduction of applicants through GP Trainee Streamlining and the Train.Work.Live campaign
- General Medical Practice Indemnity (GMPI), the new, state-backed scheme to cover the NHS activities of all General Medical Practice staff for claims arising from 1 April 2019
- The Wales National Workforce Reporting System, a primary care workforce tool providing necessary identification of all GPs and health professionals employed in GP practices to be covered by General Medical Practice Indemnity and enabling greater workforce planning
- All Wales Locum Register listing, the first point of contact for practices to identify GP Locums registered on the All Wales Locum Register, Medical Performers List and ensuring that locum GPs benefit from the Scheme for General Medical Practice Indemnity.

NHS Wales Shared Services Partnership (NWSSP) have welcomed the opportunity to work in partnership with GPC Wales and Welsh Government to deliver these new services to GP Practices.
