

Substantive GP Contractor/Salaried



GP contractors, all their employed staff engaged in any of the primary medical services arrangements listed by the Regulations (below) will automatically be covered by GMPI and **do not** need to take any further action unless, they wish to work as a GP Locum outside of their registered practice.

"primary medical services": health services provided under a contract, arrangement or agreement made under or by virtue of the following sections of the NHS Wales Act 2006:

- (a) section 41(2) (primary medical services);

Commissioned/Sub-contracted Out of Hours contracts are likely to be captured by the scheme, provided that they are "primary medical services" arrangements as per the definition in the (Clinical Negligence Scheme) (Wales) 2019 Regulations, namely:

Health services provided under a contract, arrangement or agreement made under or by virtue of the following sections of the NHS Wales Act 2006:

- (a) section 41(2) (primary medical services);
- (b) section 42(1) (general medical services contracts);
- (c) section 50 (arrangements by Local Health Boards for the provision of primary medical services)

Any locums working for a Commissioned/Sub-contracted provider, may rely on any pre-existing OOH indemnity arrangements with a Health Board until the date that they join GMPI. They should however apply to join the scheme for cover going forward.

Where the OOH service is provided direct by a Health Board and it either employs staff or itself engages locums/agency workers, those staff will all be covered by the long-standing NHS indemnity in any event, in the same way as hospital doctors.

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Managed Practice Locum GP



Where a Locum GP works at a "managed practice" i.e. for a Health Board that provides or manages its own out of hours services, longstanding NHS indemnity will apply.


