Data Quality – Hints & Tips

Many Dental Practices incorporate the WNWRS as part of their induction and leavers processes, so it's updated as soon as staff members arrive or leave the practice. Other practices have monthly or quarterly calendar reminders to validate their data. Please ensure that you have all mandatory information before creating a staff record including NI Number, Registration Number (Clinical Only), DOB, Contract Type and Contracted/Working Hours.
