Which roles do I need to capture on the WNWRS?

All staff engaged at your GP Practice should be added to the WNWRS for workforce planning purpose and to fulfil the [requirements outlined in the Scheme for GMPI](#). It is also important for Additional Capacity payments to ensure there is no delay in validation.

Here are some roles that should be captured:

- Bank Staff including Nurses
- Zero Hour Partners (Clinical & Non-Clinical)
- GP Retainers
- GP Returners
- GP Academic Fellows

Please do not enter any new Staff Records for any GP Trainees and Registrars. We are able to obtain this data from a different source to feed the reporting module.
