### **Physician Associate recruitment – students qualifying in November 2023.**

The student streamlining recruitment timeline for the Physicians Associates qualifying in November 2023 has been agreed, with the opportunity for posts in Primary Care to be added to the process and advertised to students. We have interest from a number of students wishing to work in Primary Care upon qualification.

The Student Streamlining Process is a programme specifically tailored to match student health professionals to positions in NHS Wales Health Boards and Trusts in preparation for when they complete their studies. The process has been designed to minimise duplication of effort on the part of the students and Health Boards as all vacancies are advertised at one time on one platform and students are required to submit only one application form.
