

# Wales National Workforce and Reporting System (WNWRS)

## Foundation Pharmacist Training

HEIW are looking for GP practices to support with Foundation Pharmacist training across Wales. From 2022/23 all trainee pharmacists in Wales will be trained on a 12 month rotational multi-sector programme spending 4 months in GP practice, hospital and community pharmacy.

There are a number of opportunities available to deliver 4 month rotations for Trainee Pharmacists for the 2022/23 training year starting in August as well as for the 2023/24 programme (entries due to be inputted in oriel during March. Full training will be provided along with an integrated curriculum, handbooks and training agreements.

Trainee pharmacists are employed via the single lead employer model and GP practices will be reimbursed with a training grant of £3000 per 4 month rotation. As per the regulator guidance the programme requires a pharmacist at the practice to be the Designated Supervisor.
