Certificate of Sponsorship

We are pleased to announce the release of a Welsh Government funded model for GP Practices who wish to establish the right sponsorship as part of their employment of a newly qualified GP.

The funding of Home Office fees is supported by Welsh Government and enables Practices to claim reimbursement for the Licence set up fee, as well as the individual's Sponsorship cost. If you are a Practice who has already set up a Sponsor Licence, Welsh Government have confirmed that they will retrospectively reimburse the costs you have so far incurred in terms of the Licence process from the 1 April 2021. Reimbursement of these fees will be via NHS Wales Shared Services Partnership Corporate Finance Department.

As a reminder, NWSSP also provide a free advertising service to GP Practices enabling Practices to <u>advertise their vacancies</u> on <u>GPWales</u>. We will direct all <u>GP Trainees</u> to this site when looking for a position. We also recommend that you amend your Practice Description on GP Wales if you have been/are successful in your Sponsor Licence application to highlight to potential applicants that you are able to provide sponsorship if required.

Locum Indemnity

Please be aware that access to General Medical Practice Indemnity (GMPI) is different for substantive staff and Locum GPs.

For substantive staff, access to GMPI is via entry on the WNWRS.

Locum GPs access is via inclusion on the MPL, the All Wales Locum Register (AWLR) and record all their shifts worked on Locum Hub Wales (GP Wales), as per the Guidance in Appendix B of the Scheme for GMPI.
