Wales National Workforce and Reporting System (WNWRS)

Data Extract 30/06/2022

Thank you to the **77%** of Practices across Wales who have already logged into the WNWRS this quarter and validated their data. If you haven't already done so, please log into the WNWRS as soon as possible and check all the staff records are correct for your Practice. An easy way to do this is to run a report that creates an excel spreadsheet of your Practice staff records where you can check all the details on one page. To do this:

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- Select the Data Reporting Module
- Select Reports, then Excel Reports
- Select Practice in Organisation Type
- Start typing in your Practice name and then select your Practice in Select Organisation
- In Report Type select Practice Staff Report
- Select Generate Report
- Open and amend the excel report, filtering out the 'leavers' and checking the 'active' records are correct

Focus on: Staff Roles

We are pleased to announce that we have recently launched a new staff role in the WNWRS. The role of 'Administrator' is now available to select in the Admin/Non-Clinical section of the site. Please review your Admin/Non-Clinical team and see if this title would suit any of your team who have previously been labelled with the role of 'other'.

Please also be aware that if you engage cleaners or gardeners, then they should be reflected as 'estates and ancillary' rather than 'other'.

If you have a deputy or finance Manager within your Practice, please ensure they have a staff role of 'Manager' in the WNWRS.
