We Want to Celebrate Three Amazing Achievements for Wales National Workforce Reporting System (WNWRS)

100% of Practices in Wales have their staff data captured in the WNWRS and we have supported Legal & Risk Services to identify those GPs and Health Professionals employed in GP Practices who required assistance from the team to access the Scheme for General Medical Practice Indemnity (GMPI) - [NHS Wales Shared Services Partnership](#). Being listed on the WNWRS is a necessary part of the arrangements.

Additional Capacity Payments (ACP) claims can be validated by the data on WNWRS across all Health Boards. Working collaboratively with Health Boards we have agreed a joint approach to streamline administration of the ACP claim process. Did you know drop-in sessions run jointly by NHS Wales Shared Services Partnership (NWSSP) and Health Boards have taken place and additional sessions will be scheduled by request.

GP Practices capturing their current vacancies in WNWRS have helped build a picture of gaps in the service by Health Board and Job Role. This information can be especially useful for newly qualified GPs looking to settle and start their career as a GP in Wales. All practice vacancies can be advertised through GPWales which links through to NHS Jobs reaching the widest audience.

Thank you to all our Practice Managers across Wales for your continued engagement with your WNWRS, we really appreciate working together!

Need help getting your Locums to record their shift on Locum Hub Wales (LHW)?

We do have some suggestions with regards on how to help support this:

- Highlight to your locum GPs that the inaccurate recording of locum shifts puts their access to indemnity at risk as stated in the GMPI guidelines which could expose both the locum and the practice to legal risk.
- Try to advertise shifts in LHW in advance where possible. When a locum accepts these pre-logged shifts in LHW the shift data is uploaded into WNWRS in real time as opposed to being on the monthly update.
- Log in regularly to LHW and review the 'My Locums' section, where you can track the practice's engagement with your locum GPs.
- Allow locums the opportunity to record their shift whilst at your Practice.
