

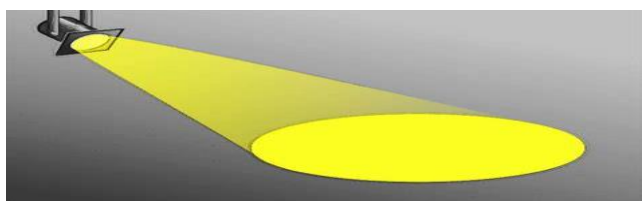

If you have any GP sessions where you need to engage a Locum GP, please register and post the shift on [Locum Hub Wales \(GP Wales\)](#).

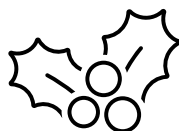
