### Upgrades to GP Wales (Locum Hub Wales)

Following feedback from users and stakeholders, we are pleased to announce that GP Wales has undergone a series of improvements to their website. This includes the following:

- Ability to give a reason when declining a Locum from a drop-down selection and/or adding an optional note. This is emailed to the Locum as part of the response given if they are unsuccessful at obtaining a shift at your Practice.
- Shifts can now be entered concurrently, for example a 09:00-13:00 followed by a 13:00-17:00 shift.
- The Locum contact information is now also available in the shift details area, in addition to the 'my Locums' page.

This should lead to an improved experience for all users. Please use this link to visit **GP Wales (Locum Hub Wales)** to post any vacancies and advertise any GP Locum shifts available at your Practice. We have recently received some positive feedback regarding an increase of available Locum GPs in certain areas of Wales. Please ensure you maximise your opportunities to fill any vacancies or Locum shifts at your Practice by using the GP Wales website.
