

What is Clinical Waste?

Infectious Clinical Waste in a domestic setting is:

- ✓ Dressings or Bandages contaminated with blood
- ✓ Needles, syringes or other sharps
- ✓ Diabetic Sharps Waste
- ✓ Dialysis Waste

To comply with regulations, this waste requires disposal in Orange bags (*infectious*), or appropriate sharps bin (see below for guide)



We ask that you:

- ✓ Please ensure that you do not mix any other waste with your clinical waste (*i.e. offensive hygiene waste or household rubbish placed in clinical waste bags*)
- ✓ Recycle ALL clean packaging

Correct Disposal:

Household Waste Black Waste

If your waste falls into one of the categories below you may dispose of it with your household black bag waste for collection by the council.

Incontinence Pads

Stoma, catheter / colostomy bags

Orange

Infectious waste, for example Wipes, Gloves, Dressings, Bandages, Aprons etc.

Sharps Bins

For the safe storage and disposal of any sharps waste, for example Needles, Syringes & 'Fingerstick' devices used for testing blood.
