Our Control Room

As part of ongoing improvements to the way we deliver our services, a new Communication Hub has been introduced in Cardiff. The Hub is designed to manage routine, urgent and emergency (i.e. blue light) requests in strict accordance with the Service Level Agreements and Emergency Activation Protocols held.



Calls received at the Hub are managed consistently, in line with our deployment criteria.

We use various vehicles, which include small vans, 3.5t vans, lorries, emergency support vehicles and 4x4 vehicles in adverse weather conditions etc.

Our Hub operates between 08:00 and 17:00hrs, Monday to Friday. Out of hours, calls are managed by one of our partners to facilitate the call and our operational services are supported by the On Call Manager.
