## **General information and publication of the 2013/14 Estates and Facilities Performance Management System (EFPMS) report and availability of associated supplementary data**

As you may be aware, EFPMS reports have recently been the subject of a Welsh Government review, and this year NHS Wales Shared Services Partnership – Specialist Estates Services (NWSSP–SES) have, for the first time, produced a single, streamlined report designed to meet the requirements of the Health Minister. This new report replaces the two volumes of *“The NHS Estate in Wales”* published between 2002 and 2013 for the Welsh Government and NHS Health Boards / Trusts. I am pleased to advise that the new report, which focuses on national KPIs, is now available for distribution.

The complete dataset, compiled from submissions by Health Boards / Trusts to the EFPMS, has been collated by NWSSP-SES and is now available for your attention in the form of a spreadsheet.

Both the streamlined report and dataset are attached with this notification and are also accessible from the publications page of the NWSSP-SES intranet site at <http://howis.wales.nhs.uk/whe>.

At the first meeting of the Estates Liaison Group last year, it was agreed that Health Boards / Trusts would be consulted on the future of EFPMS reports. The outcome of that consultation will determine the format and content of reports published next year and thereafter for the service.

I should be grateful if you would bring this notification to the attention of the managers within your organisation with responsibility for the Estates and Facilities functions.
