FIRE SAFETY AUDIT SYSTEM

As detailed in WHTM 05/01 Managing Healthcare Fire Safety, NHS Organisations are required to conduct an annual fire audit utilising the online Fire Safety Audit System. This system was released back online on 31st December 2021, following a review of the latest submissions.

Extent of audit submissions 2021/22

NHS Organisations are required to complete and submit the following by 27th May 2022.

- Level 1 audit for the whole Organisation.
- Level 2 audits for **all** hospital sites containing in-patient facilities.
- Level 2 audits for a selection of approximately 10-20% of other premises within their estate e.g. clinics, health centres or group homes.

NHS Organisations are also reminded that following submission of the audits, a report will be prepared for the Welsh Government; therefore it is **essential** that audits are submitted by the prescribed date.
