ELECTRICAL RESILIENCE SURVEY 2021

Welsh Government require Health Boards and Trusts to provide information on their existing electrical infrastructure to establish the degree to which the NHS organisations infrastructure are resilient, have sufficient capacity and are prepared for emergencies. A questionnaire has been compiled in **Annex A** which will help identify current levels of electrical capacity and resilience of key estates and facilities services associated with NHS Health Boards and Trusts in Wales. There are also questions relating to low carbon initiatives and NHS Wales decarbonisation strategy and its impact on electrical infrastructure.

It is important that all questions are answered with valid information, supplemented wherever practical with comments adjacent to each question to add value to the responses by way of clarification or expansion of details.

This survey will be followed later in the year with an additional questionnaire asking for more information on resilience encompassing climate change, facilities management (including waste) and other engineering services.

Responses should be provided by 5th April 2022.
