ASSETS COLLABORATION PROGRAMME WALES GRANT SCHEME – PHASE 3

Further to SESN 22/11, the purpose of this SESN is to bring your attention to the recent launch of a further round of the Assets Collaboration Programme Wales grant scheme (ACPW3) for 2023/24.

You will note that the Ystadau Cymru Welsh Government launch letter states that ACPW3 supports public sector collaboration to deliver against priorities in the current Programme for Government and that the first priority listed is 'Providing effective, high quality and sustainable healthcare'. In summary, the grant: is aimed at supporting collaboration between Welsh public sector organisations, must involve public sector land or property assets, must either remove some of the barriers to collaboration or contribute to the delivery of a sustainable future public sector estate, is open to applications for between £10,000 and £75,000 (revenue) and of up to £250,000 for capital projects, must be spent on projects that will complete by the 31 March 2024.


